RULES

1 All events start from scratch.

Class A events for boys under 13 years

Class B , , , 14 ,, Class C , , 15 ,, Class D , , 16 ,,

Class E open Championship events.

Ages taken are those on 31st July, 1932

- 2 All events, except Event 27, count for the House Championship.
- 3 A first place counts 3 points, second 2 points third 1 point.
- 4 The House with the highest aggregate of points wins the Athletic Championship Shield.

(Each House was allowed to enter three competitors for each event. Preliminary Heats have reduced the second and third "strings" to two to compete with the "first strings" on Sports Day.)

- 5 The competitor with the highest aggregate in Class E holds the School Championship Cup for one year.
- 6 The competitor with the highest aggregate in Class C holds the "Temple-Cole" Junior Cup for one year.
 - 7 Spectators are not allowed on the course.

EVENTS PREVIOUSLY DECIDED

These have been carried out during the term, standard times, heights and distances being fixed according to the ages of the boys. The House with the highest number of its boys achieving the standard in each event scores 3 points, second House 2 points, and third 1 point, towards the House Championship in Athletics.
