RULES

1. All events start from scratch.

Class A events for boys under 13 years.

Class B ,, ,, 14 ,, Class C ,, ,, 15 ,, Class D ,, ,, 16 ,,

Class E open Championship events.

Ages taken are those on 31st July, 1933.

- 2. All events, except Event 27, count for the House Championship.
- 3. A first place counts 3 points, second 2 points, third 1 point.
- 4. The House with the highest aggregate of points wins the Athletic Championship Shield.

(Each House is allowed to enter three competitors for each event. Preliminary Heats reduce the second and third "strings" to two to compete with the "first strings" on Sports Day.)

- 5. No competitor is allowed to enter for more than three running events; and no more than five events in all.
- 6. The competitor with the highest aggregate in Class E holds the School Championship Cup for one year.
- 7. The competitor with the highest aggregate in Class C holds the "Temple-Cole" Junior Cup for one year.
 - 18. Spectators are not allowed on the course.
