RULES

- 1. All competitors must be in full-time attendance at one of the member-schools of the Association.
- 2. Competitors' age-groups are as follows: Junior, under 14; Middle, 14 to 16; Senior, over 16. (All ages are reckoned to 31st July, 1956.
- 3. No competitor may enter for more than two individual events, of which only one may be a track event. For the purpose of this rule the hurdles race is a track event.
- 4. At the Finals Meeting, competitors taking part are those who gained first and second place in their events at the group meetings. Only one competitor, however, may enter from any one school in each individual event in the Finals.
- 5. No substitution is allowed between the Group and Finals meeting except in the composition of the Relay Teams.
- 6. The winner of each Final shall receive 6 points and the Association's plaque; the second, 5 points; the third, 4 points; the fourth, 3 points; the fifth, 2 points; and the sixth, 1 point.
- 7. The Bowles Cup shall be won by the School gaining the highest aggregate of points in Senior events; the Thurston cup by the School gaining the highest aggregate of points in the Middle events, and the Junior Shield by the School gaining the highest aggregate of points in the Junior events.
- 8. Each competitor must have the number of his school securely fastened to both front and back of his running vest. Figures must be in black and at least six inches high.
- 9. Competitors must retire to the enclosure immediately after their events. Infringements of this rule will disqualify for further events.
- 10. Only officials and competitors are allowed in the dressing rooms and enclosure or on the course.
 - 11. No coaching is allowed on the course.
 - 12. Throwing the Javelin.
- Senior—The Javelin shall weigh 1 lb. 8½ ozs. and be 7 ft. 6½ ins. long.
- Middle—The Javelin shall weigh 1 lb. $5\frac{1}{4}$ ozs. and be 7 ft. $2\frac{1}{4}$ ins. long.
 - 13. Throwing the Discus.
- Senior—The Discus shall weigh 3 lbs. 5 ozs. and be 8 ins. in diameter.
- Middle—The Discus shall weigh 2 lbs. 3½ ozs. and be 7 ins. in diamtere.
 - Putting the Weight.
- Senior-The Weight shall be 12 lbs.
- Middle—The Weight shall be 8 lbs. 13 ozs.
 - 15. Hurdles.
- Senior—110 yards, 10 hurdles, 3 ft. high and 9 yards apart; distance to first hurdle, 15 yards, distance from last hurdle, 14 yards.
- Middle—80 yards, 7 hurdles, 2 ft. 6 ins. high and 8 yards apart; distance to first hurdle, 15 yards, distance from last hurdle, 17 yards.
