#### KILBURN GRAMMAR SCHOOL.

Tour of the Soviet Union, 1965.

I am now able to give further details of this tour; the demand for places was so unexpectedly great that it was decided to take two separate parties, and I have now been given particulars of sailing dates by the agents, together with details of available excursions and their cost.

The total cost for the tour will be £69 0 0; this price includes travel from London back to London by rail and sea, sleeper accommodation where necessary, full board in hotels, all meals except for the first day, excursions inside the Soviet Union and all necessary visas. I have also included the optional coach excursions in West Berlin, East Berlin, Helsinki, Stockholm and Copenhagen, which are well worth taking in view of the limited time available.

### Passports.

All members of the party must have their own passports, costing 30/- for five years, as the Russian authorities do not accept group passports of the British annual passport. I shall give details of this later.

#### Insurance.

The cost includes insurance for the party, and I think it will be unnecessary for parents to take out additional cover, though they may do so if they wish.

## Payment.

A deposit of £6 0 0 per head has to be paid to confirm our bookings, and I should like to receive this from boys selected by Friday, December 4<sup>th</sup>. The balance may be paid either by cheque some five weeks before we leave or in instalments between now and then. All cheques should be made payable to "Kilburn Grammar School Travel Account".
