THE COMPLETE SCHOOL IN 1933

This year saw the production of class photographs. These were put into small folders measuring $6\frac{3}{4}$ inches by $4\frac{1}{4}$ inches which were held shut with a metal press stud.

It might have been assumed that these folders were produced because panoramic photographs (where the camera rotates and takes many snaps which are then put together to form a long photograph) had not been invented.

But this cannot be so because our website contains a panoramic photograph of the whole school which was taken in 1929.

I have four of these folders, all dated 1933, but they are of very limited use now because no details of the various classes are provided and no boys or staff are identified by name. However, a total of 451 boys and 24 members of staff appear in 18 photographs.

These folders are retained mainly for historic interest. Only a few of our members would know or be able to recognise boys who attended the school so long ago.
