SCHOOL PANORAMIC PHOTOGRAPHS

It is not known how many panoramic photographs were taken during the life of the School, but eight of them are available on the Members Only page of this website.

Most of them were taken by Panora, a company based in Clerkenwell, east London, but at least one was taken by a different company while the school was evacuated to Northampton during the war.

Each photograph is reproduced in twelve slightly overlapping sections. The example shown below is one section of the 1929 photograph.

Members of the OBA can view all eight photographs, which were taken in 1929, 1937, 1940, 1949, 1955, 1959, 1962 and 1967. Despite problems of ageing and frequent use, most of the pupils and staff can easily be recognised.

The boys appearing in these photographs are identified by a tag and their names, where known, are shown underneath each section
